Mid Year Reports

Your child will be receiving their mid-year report in the last week of term. The reports will let you know your child's reading age and their curriculum level for Maths and Writing. When you look at these levels, please bear in mind that we are only halfway through the year. Your child's report will show you where they are working currently and at the end of the year will show their new level. This allows us to show progress over the course of the year and enables you to celebrate your child's progress with them. Every child is unique and learns at their own pace. Sometimes they will make accelerated progress and at other times they will plateau – this is quite normal. Please have a look at the Years and Curriculum Levels illustration on the report which shows that children usually take two to three years to work through each curriculum level but can often take longer. If you have any concerns about your child's learning, remember we are always here to help. You are welcome to make an appointment with your child's teacher at any time during the year. Either email your child's teacher (addresses are available on our website) or contact the school office to make an appointment.

<u>Matariki</u>

The sighting of the Matariki constellation marks the dawning of the Māori New Year. This is a time to be with family and friends, to reflect on the past, to celebrate those who are not with us anymore and to prepare for the year ahead. Many events will be held around New Zealand to celebrate this time, with a public holiday on the 14th July. Classes at Katikati Primary School will celebrate in many different ways. One of the highlights will be a performance by our Kapa Haka group on Thursday the 29th June. Weather permitting, we are planning to hold the performance at 10.30am on Matakana deck.
