## Uniform

If you are buying new clothes for school over the holidays, please remember that the children need to be wearing one of our Katikati Primary School T-shirts with the school logo and that on the bottom they should be wearing a skirt, shorts or trousers which are plain navy blue or black. If any families need assistance with uniform, we have our second hand uniform store open on Mondays from 8.15 – 8.45 in the back of the school hall or you can have a quiet word with your child's class teacher if you need assistance. We would really appreciate you making sure that your child has the correct uniform to come back and start the new year.

## Clapping Out

Our Year 6 students will be clapped out of School on the 19<sup>th</sup> December at 2.40pm. This is a tradition of our school where we say the final good-bye to the Year 6 students who are leaving our school to move on to college. The younger students line the walkways and wish their friends well as they leave. Parents are most welcome to join us to farewell our senior students.

<u>Sun Safety:</u> With the weather warming up we have opened the school pool and we also have a number of special events planned to mark the end of the year, many of which are outside. We are hoping that the weather is going to be kind to us. Even on cloudy days the sun is very strong at this time of year, so please make sure that your child is coming to school with a wide brimmed hat and wearing sunscreen. Sunscreen will be available in the classrooms, please let us know if your child is allergic to the lotion. If your child burns easily, please let the class teacher know and provide them with a light weight, long sleeved top.

This special event will be held on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December from 9.15am until 11am at the Katikati College Action Centre. With the help of our POTS group, there will also be an evening event for the Year 6 students on the 14th December, with dinner and a disco especially for them. Please put this date in your diaries!



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
