



UNIFORM AGREEMENT

INTRODUCTION:

Children are expected to wear their Katikati Primary School uniform to show that they belong to and are proud to attend our school.

GUIDELINES:

Our uniform items are:

1. Polo shirt with Katikati Primary School logo on left hand side.
2. Sweatshirt and/ or polar fleece – bottle green.
3. Bottom garment should be black or navy blue, preferably Schooltex range sourced from The Warehouse. Jeans are not encouraged.
4. Wide brimmed sunhats in the 1st and 4th term. **Caps, beanies and hoodies are not acceptable clothing.**
5. Jewellery – Acceptable sleeper studs or a watch only. (Items of cultural significance can be worn but the school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage or for any injury caused by wearing the item of jewellery. Teachers may ask a child to take an item of jewellery off if they think it poses a safety risk e.g. necklaces worn during sporting events).
6. Personal media devices of any type are not allowed at school, this includes Smart watches.
7. Shoes – style and colour are your choice.

CONSEQUENCES:

1. Children without sunhats in the 1st and 4th term will sit/play in the shade.
2. If a child is coming to school in inappropriate, non-uniform items the class teacher will make contact in the first instance. The Area Deputy Principal will follow up if needed.
