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Year 5 and 6 Expectations:

Uniform:

Cross Country:

Cross Country training starts this week, with all classes participating on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday morning for 20 minutes. We encourage all students to take part in these training sessions, whether it be running, jogging or walking. These training sessions build towards our school wide Cross Country which is taking place in Week 4. More information about this event will come out closer to the time, with date, time and volunteer help.

Treasuring Our Place:

After a very successful programme in 2023, we will continue to take part in the Treasuring Our Place Programme, run in consultation between the school and the Western Bay of Plenty Museum. This year we will be focusing on Healthy Forests and Animal and Plant Pests, using visits to our school gully and nursery to support our learning. Each class will participate in 6 in-class sessions and practical sessions in helping look after the gully and nursery. Detailed information for parents of the classes involved this term, will be sent out this week.

Team 3 Afternoon Rotation:

Over the next 2 terms, our students will be taking part in a Wider Curriculum Rotation on Thursday afternoons. On a 3 week rotation, each class will participate in a range of learning activities based around Music, Dance, Drama, Visual Art, Te Reo and Digital Technologies. We encourage all students to participate in these activities and enjoy learning across the different areas of the curriculum.

This report will report on your child's reading, writing and maths and progress across the wider curriculum made so far this year.
