Year 5/6 Finlay Park Adventure Camp 2023 Information Letter #3

Final Camp Costing:

Thank you to all students, parents and whanau for your support in fundraising towards camp over the past two terms. We were very pleased with the amount of money raised and this has made an impact on the final cost of camp. With fundraising efforts we have managed to reduce the cost per student from \$240 to \$210.

Thank you to all parents who have let us know that they would like their child to attend camp and those who have given the school \$50. This leaves \$160 to cover the cost of each child's camp. We continue to encourage the use of Online Kindo School Shop and Eftpos for money coming into the school.

Term 2 Individual Fundraiser:

Thank you for all the support shown towards fundraising for our camp. We now move into individual fundraising in Term 2, with our Raffle being the main focus. Please see the attached notice for more information if you are interested in taking part in this fundraiser.

Parent Volunteers:

Thank you to all the parents who put their name forward to be a parent volunteer at camp. We really appreciate the overwhelming support we have had from all parents in making our Yr 5/6 camp happen. We are now in the process of finalising parents and will be in contact with you all via mail over the next week.

In Term 2, Medical Consent, Swimming Consent and Student Contracts will be sent home that need to be completed by both parents and students. It is important that this information is carefully read and correctly completed to ensure the health and safety of your child at camp.

Clothing, Equipment and Food:

All children will require a comprehensive gear list, including a sleeping bag, thermals (pants and top), raincoat, beanie and gloves, sturdy covered-in footwear and woollen socks for their time away. On the back of this newsletter you will find a detailed list so that you can start looking out for these items, borrowing from family and checking out sales.

The weather in September can be unpredictable and change quickly but as students are moving about most of the day, shorts and t-shirts are also required.

Year 5/6 Finlay Park Adventure Camp 2023 Raffle Fundraiser

Help us to get all of our Year 5 and 6 students to camp. As part of our efforts to fundraise for our camp in Term 3, the students are able to sell raffle tickets from the start of Term 2. This is an optional fundraiser, to help reduce the cost of your child attending camp.

For a raffle sheet of 20 tickets, sold at \$2.00 each, your child will earn \$40.00 towards the cost of camp.

If you or child/children wish to sell raffle tickets as a fundraiser then please read, fill in the permission slip/order form and return to your classroom teacher by the end of Week 1 in Term 2. Students will then be provided with the raffle tickets to sell.

Once you have sold all your raffle tickets, return the money and completed raffle ticket sheet to Miss Graveson - Rm 26. Please ensure you have counted all the money and therefore is the correct amount (this will then be deposited into the office).

Students have the option to sell as many raffle tickets as they wish. A new raffle sheet will be allocated to your child once a completed raffle ticket sheet and correct money has been returned. Please indicate on the permission slip how many sheets in total you would like your child to sell during the fundraising time - this will help with giving an estimate of sheets required during organisation.

For each raffle ticket sheet, there are 20 tickets to be sold at \$2.00 each.

Please be aware that no additional raffle sheets will be issued until all outstanding money is returned.

All raffle ticket sheets and money are due in to Miss Graveson - Rm 26, by Friday 2nd June.
