## COVID Update

On behalf of the staff, I wanted to say a huge thank you to our families for being so supportive of the school now that we unfortunately have had some COVID cases linked to our school. I have received a number of lovely emails this week which are very much appreciated. I realise that this is an unsettling time for everyone, it is a real tribute to our community in Katikati that everyone pulls together.

We have been notified of additional cases today and have a number of children who are being kept at home either as they are household contacts or as a precaution by the family. I will email out an update regarding cases at school on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. We are able to provide work if children are at home at present, packs can be picked up from outside the school office or you can contact your **child's teacher if needed**.

Currently school is still open as normal for all children who are feeling well to attend and our staff are doing a great job of keeping programmes running and creating a positive environment for the children. Obviously, it is really important if your child is unwell or showing any symptoms that they are kept at home. Please inform the school if your child has tested positive. If you are keeping your child home for any reason, please advise us of the reason they are away and when they will be likely to return to school. If you need to get anyone in your household tested, there will be a testing station set up in the car park behind the old BNZ building every Monday and Thursday from 1pm until 3pm.

## <u>Sun Safety</u>

Please remember that it is compulsory for your child to wear a sun hat when they are outside this term. This includes break times and sporting events. The children are

going to miss out on a range of learning and fun activities if they don't have their hat. Any wide brimmed hat is acceptable. Hats can also be purchased from the school office. Please help us to keep your child safe in the sun by sending them to school with their hat.

### Catching the Bus

Just a reminder, if your child catches the bus to go home but there is a change of plans and you

come in to pick them up, please let the office know. For Health and Safety reasons we need to know who is on the bus each day in case the bus breaks down or is caught up in an accident.

## Upcoming Events


Some events at the school have had to be cancelled this term but there are still activities for the children to look
