ERICA Community Cards

ERICA Community Cards are an important part of our positive behaviour system at Katikati Primary School and it is heartening to see children working hard for these awards. Children collect stamps on their cards when they show our school values of Excellence, Respect, Integrity, Citizenship and positive Attitude. To earn a Bronze Award the children have to complete 5 cards, 10 cards for Silver and 15 cards for Gold. Every child who earns a Bronze, Silver or Gold Award receives a wrist band in their house colour and two children who have completed cards that week are drawn out to receive a prize. It has been wonderful this term to see our children working so hard to complete their cards and earn their certificates. Thank you to families who have supported our Mufti Day Fundraisers this term as the money raised goes towards buying rewards for our behaviour system. Congratulations to our first ERICA Bronze Award winner for 2022, Skylah Rae Katipa. Skylah Rae has worked extremely hard showing Erica's values and we are extremely proud of her.

Children who stood out to their teachers for showing our values will be put into a draw to win a voucher.
