#### Welcome Back to Term 2

We would like to say a huge welcome to all the new students and to extend a special welcome to the new families who are starting with us for the first time. We would also like to welcome a new staff member, Brittany Kerebs, who is teaching in Room 4. I would like to remind you that Andrea Nicholson is away on sabbatical for the whole of Term 2 and will be back on board at the beginning of Term 3. The change to Leadership is Amanda Willett is in the Acting Principal role, with both Kristy Graveson and Rachelle Gibbons-Campbell sharing the Deputy Principal role.

Our Term Value- Respect: At KKPS we choose one of our ERICA values each term to have a special focus on. For Term 2, our school is focussing on RESPECT. This is an important skill for children to learn and we have a variety of activities in classes to promote how we respect ourselves, each other and our school environment. A particular area of learning for students is how we talk to adults and each other in a respectful manner as well as how we show respect in the classroom, playground, library and hall. Talking to your children about speaking respectfully at home and encouraging them to practise this skill, will support them in their learning.

Anzac Day: Three ex-KKPS students - Scarlett Colquhoun, Monty Groenewald and Blake Cousins represented our school last Anzac Day, as part of a documentary being put together by Jude Dobson, a former TV presenter, and Andrew Mehrtens (ex- All Black). As part of this documentary, Andrew visited the war graves of 13 ex-All Blacks who died in battle during WW1. One of the very notable graves that he visited was that of Dave Gallaher - who features on the mural on the side of Room 1. The Gallaher family are a valued part of our history at KKPS, with his mother, Maria, being the school's first headmaster/ teacher in 1879 and she taught in the classroom that is now Room 2. Dave, aged 6, was a foundation student of KKPS.

We are extremely proud of Scarlett, Monty and Blake for how they represented our school, with their brilliant research, questions and waiata. The documentary piece 'All Blacks at War' was aired on TV1 and RNZ on Anzac Day last week. This documentary is available to view on TV1 On Demand.

#### SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY




