Hats

Please remember that it is school policy that the children wear sunhats **when they are outside in Term 4. If they don't have a hat at breaktimes,** they will be required to stay in the shade. Please help us to keep your child safe from the sun by making sure they have a hat at school. Hats are available for purchase at the school office at a cost of \$14.00. The children are welcome to wear any large brimmed hat they have at home.



Keeping our Children Safe

1. **School Drop Off Zone** - Please take note of the regulations regarding the school loading zone which is outside the back of Rooms 1 and 2. Between 8 and 9.00 in the morning and 2.30 and 3.30 in the afternoon, these zones are for picking up and dropping children off only. Vehicles should not be parked here during these times and no one should be waiting for more than 5 minutes for their child. These rules are in place to try and keep our children safe and to keep traffic flowing. If you need a place to park up, we are extremely fortunate that both the church and the bowling club are happy for you to use their



spaces, as long as they don't have a function on. If they do, please be respectful, we would hate to lose the goodwill of the club or the church and be no longer welcome to park on their grounds.

2. If you are parking in our visitor bays at the start or end of the school day, please make sure you are driving slowly and with extreme care. It is very difficult for pedestrians to see around the buses and you need to be able to stop if any of the children dart across the crossings.

Open Morning for all children starting Term 1 2023: We welcome all children who will be starting in Term 1 2023 to our open morning on Friday November 18th from 9.30-11.00. This is a great time to enrol your child at school if you haven't already done so. Please bring a piece of fruit for fruit break. We are having our Ready for School visits early in the term as all children need to have 3 visits before starting at school (2 Fridays and 1 Thursday). This will allow all children to have had their visits by the start of Term 1. The open morning will answer many questions about starting at school. You can also contact me if you have any concerns.

Erica All Stars

A huge congratulations to all those children who have earned their Gold Award and are now working to become Erica All Stars. Our All Stars Award is the highest honour children can earn at our school. These awards are presented at the Year 6 graduation or the end of year assemblies for our younger students. Once they have completed their Gold Award, children will be given a booklet to bring home. The booklet details what they have to do in order to earn their All Stars Award. The activities will take about 6 weeks to complete and are all geared at demonstrating our school values. Children are challenged with tasks such as: setting up games for younger children at playtimes; helping out in our school library; making sure our school is free of litter and (one that will be very popular with whanau) undertaking chores to help out at home. Once the children have completed these tasks, their booklet will be signed off and they will become one of our All Stars.

Attendance

Across New Zealand attendance has been heavily impacted by Covid over the last two years. Now that restrictions have eased and case numbers in our local area have dropped, it is a good time to encourage our children to attend school regularly. Next term we are intending to have two prizes for children to work towards, one for children whose attendance for term 4 is above 94% and one for children who have shown great improvement in their level of attendance. In order to show how highly we value regular attendance, every child who attends more than 94% of the time in Term 4 or has shown great improvement in their attendance will be awarded a certificate. They will also go into a draw to win a \$50 pizza voucher for their family to enjoy. There will be one voucher for children with regular attendance and one for great improvement in attendance. We know that sickness has gotten in the way significantly this year, we are hoping for a really positive term 4.

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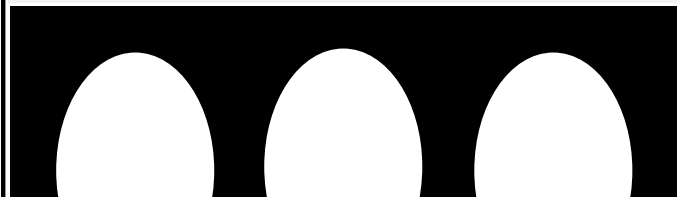
